6. Proposal to change membership fees and arrangements:
  - a. Junior member (9-15yrs old) £60, price is inclusive of a parent/guardian becoming a supporting member of the club, which is now a mandatory requirement. Subsequent children in the family will pay £50.
  - b. Senior membership cost (16yrs plus) £50
  - c. Road Runners annual fee £40
  - d. Supporting members will remain unchanged at £10
  - e. All second claim athletes will now be charged £40
  - f. Move to online system;
  - g. Once fees are agreed at the AGM, the system will be live;
  - h. The link will be put on the Club website, Facebook and emailed to all members;
  - i. The options for existing members will stay open until 8th April (the day before the club championships)
  - j. At that point entries for existing members will close. There will be no extensions or second chances to join as an existing member;
  - k. Anyone who has not joined will not be allowed to compete at the Club Championships. If they have entered the entry fee will not be refunded (and this will be clearly stated in the T&C for Club Championships);
  - l. Each coach will be given a list of athletes for their group who have paid. If athletes are Under 18 they will be asked to leave the club;
  - m. If athletes are over 18 it is the coaches decision whether they wish to continue coaching, however must remember they are not insured if the athlete is not a member of a Scottish Athletics affiliated club;
  - n. Any late payers will have to re-join as a new member. New members pay a £20 joining fee which covers the cost of a Club vest or crop top.
