- The first cross country fixture of December was the Scottish East District XC Championships held on Saturday 6th December at Camperdown Park, Dundee. This was the event that was vital to athletes if they wished to gain automatic selection into the Scottish Inter – District XC Championships which is to be held in January.
- ▶ Under 13 Girls (3200m) Sarah Coutts 1st 12:57, Jenny Gillanders – 8th – 13:23, Jennifer Brydon – 15th – 13:54, Lauren Blair – 19th – 13:57, Jemma Jamieson – 24th – 14:31, Ailsa Barr – 34th – 14:57, Lucy Telfer – 48th – 17:05 and Kym McAlpine – 61st – 19:43. The team of Sarah Coutts, Jenny Gillanders and Jennifer Brydon won the silver team medal with 24 points. Sarah Coutts and Jenny Gillanders have now been selected to represent Scotland East at the Inter – District Championships in January at Hollyrood Park.
- Under 13 Boys (3200m) Lewis Blair 4th 12:16, Lewis Dow – 15th – 12:39, Euan Johnston – 40th – 13:38, Matthew Litch – 47th – 13:54 and Gregor McPherson – 60th – 14:43. The team of Lewis Blair, Lewis Dow and Euan Johnston came 4th place in team positions with 59 points. Lewis Blair has now been selected to represent Scotland East at the Inter – District Championships in January at Hollyrood Park.
